

NOTICE: CHANGE OF EFFECTIVE DATE

RELIABILITY STANDARD IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES

Date of Notice: 15 February 2018

AEMO recently consulted on the new Reliability Standard Implementation Guidelines as part of the Medium Term Projected Assessment of System Adequacy (MTPASA) project.

This notice informs the Reliability Panel, all Registered Participants and interested parties that the effective date for the new Reliability Standard Implementation Guidelines scheduled for 15 February 2018 has been delayed.

The effective date for these new Guidelines has been changed due to delays in the MT PASA production release. AEMO anticipates the MT PASA production release will occur towards the end of April, but no later than 30 May 2018. The effective date of the amended RSIG will be aligned with this production release. The Final Report, Guidelines and MT PASA Process Description have been updated to reflect this change.

There are no changes to the Guidelines. In the meantime, the current Guidelines will continue in effect. AEMO apologises for any inconvenience caused by this delay.
