1. Welcome and attendance / apologies - Roger Shaw, AEMO

Roger Shaw (AEMO) welcomed all to the meeting.

Paul Bresloff-Barry (Agora Energy) was an apology.

2. Previous meeting minutes and actions - Roger Shaw, AEMO

The GWCF confirmed the previous meeting minutes as accurate.

In line action item 25.6.1, Robbie Flood (AEMO) noted that the password change had gone into effect.

In line with action item 25.8.1, Roger Shaw (AEMO) noted that it would provide an update regarding its advice to COAG on the Gas Supply Guarantee.

Secretariat note: AEMO provides the following update on the Gas Supply Guarantee.

AEMO has updated the Gas Supply Guarantee Guidelines with a new expiry date of 31 March 2023. AEMO <u>consulted on</u> this amendment between 19 February 2020 and 18 March 2020 and published a final determination on 25 March 2020. Minister Angus Taylor <u>intends to recommend</u> to the COAG EC that a review of the Guarantee mechanism be undertaken by the Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) to ensure it remains fit for purpose into the future.

3. AER standing agenda item - Robert Matton, AER

Robert Matton (AER) spoke to the day-ahead auction (DAA), renomination record keeping, auction quantity limit (AQL) submissions, and reporting of secondary capacity trades, as per the slides.

4. AEMC standing agenda item - Owen Pascoe, AEMC

Owen Pascoe (AEMC) noted that the AEMC had published final determinations on 12 March 2020 regarding the DWGM simpler wholesale price and DWGM improvement to AMDQ regime rule changes. Scott Young (APA Group) requested a discussion with the AEMC, AEMO, and the AER to determine how these changes would interact with APA Group's access arrangement changes (Action item 26.4.1). The AEMC is also conducting its Diennial review into liquidity in wholesale and gas pipeline trading markets, for which a draft report should be published in mid-April.

5. GMM general update – Robbie Flood, AEMO

Robbie Flood (AEMO) spoke to the slides regarding:



- Password changes via API.
- An alternative submissions auction quantity limit process for DAA.
- Capacity updates by 31 March.
- Gas transparency measures.
- The BB defect release.
- The BB Data Submission Procedure consultation.
- The BB biennial review.
- New connection points and name changes in the Transportation Service Point Register.

Robbie Flood (AEMO) noted that AEMO would like facility operators' feedback on whether they believed an alternative AQL submission method (that is, a method of direct upload through the market portal) would be desirable (<u>Action item 26.5.1</u>).

Secretariat note: AEMO received a question following the meeting regarding how facility operators and network operators are to update nameplate ratings and connection point nameplate ratings by 31 March. AEMO's response is included below:

Nameplate ratings are required from registered Bulletin Board facilities (transmission pipelines, compression, storage and production facilities), and connection point nameplate ratings are required to be reported by the Bulletin Board transmission pipelines.

The way it is done is through a Bulletin Board submission, which is available to all BB Participants.

6. AEMO Gas Market Monitoring standing agenda item - Darryl White, AEMO

Darryl White (AEMO) spoke to the slides.

7. DWGM maintenance rule change – Yvonne Tan, AEMO

Yvonne Tan (AEMO) spoke to the provided paper. Yvonne noted that feedback on the paper is due by COB (AEDT) 31 March 2020 and should be sent to gwcf_correspondence@aemo.com.au.

8. Implementing recent DWGM rule changes – Roger Shaw, AEMO

Roger Shaw (AEMO) spoke to the slides. Roger noted that GWCF members should nominate for the GWCF working sub-group on these changes at gwcf_correspondence@aemo.com.au by COB (AEST) 15 April 2020 (Action item 26.8.1).

9. VGPR and GSOO - Yvonne Tan, AEMO

Yvonne Tan (AEMO) noted that there is a moratorium on these documents at the moment and that they will be published by the end of March. Secretariat note: both documents can be found here.

10. Winter presentation - Yvonne Tan, AEMO

Given that COVID19 prevents gatherings the size of the winter presentation, AEMO is currently investigating whether the information that would have been delivered at the presentation should instead be delivered by teleconference or information pack.



11. Other business - Roger Shaw, AEMO

Scott Young (APA Group) invited GWCF participants to contact APA Group about the upcoming Declared Transmission System Access Arrangements consultation.

Roger Shaw (AEMO) reminded participants that all meetings would be WebEx for the near future due to COVID19. Liz Gharghori (AGL) noted that it would be helpful for slides to be provided ahead of the meeting where possible.

12. Meeting close - Roger Shaw, AEMO

Roger Shaw (AEMO) closed the meeting at 10.52am.
