2 PURPOSE	2.1.1 The purpose of this Meter Churn Procedure for financially responsible Market Participants is to define obligations that the FRMP is to follow to manage Meter Churn by minimising: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. any interruption to the flow of metering data;</li> <li>ii. the degree of 'off market' metering data transfers between Metering Data Providers;</li> <li>iii. the delay in updates to NMI Standing Data in the metering database (MSATS); and</li> <li>iv. the time frame to effect a transfer of connection point and change of responsible person.</li> </ul>	The purpose of this Meter Churn Procedure is to define obligations that the financially responsible Market Participant is to follow in the management of Meter Churn.	<b>Reworded</b> to clarify purpose and to be consistent with the National Electricity Rules.
