

STTM MARKET OPERATOR SERVICE (MOS) ALLOCATION COSTS – 2017-18

1. BACKGROUND

In line with the National Gas Rules (NGR), STTM pipeline operators have provided AEMO with an invoice for their actual 2017-18 MOS allocation service costs.

AEMO has published the 2017-18 invoices. There were no comments received.

AEMO then went to the Australian Energy Regulator (AER) and seek for their determination. On 11 September, AEMO received the determination from the AER that they are satisfied with the MOS allocation costs submitted by SEAGas, Epic Energy, Jemena and the APA Group.

The table below sets out the estimates provided, the invoices received and the final amounts paid to each pipeline operators.
