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1. Introduction

These are the release notes for the GBB (WA) 1.12 (Build 351) release. This release addresses important issues described in sections below.

This GBB (WA) release includes:

- Addition of new connection point “Agnew” to the Network Topology map,
- A fix for Internet Explorer caching issue when loading the Network Topology map,
- Improvements to the Production and Consumption Flows visualisation.

These resolved issues under this release are described in the sections below.

1.1 GBB (WA) Version Summary



2. External Changes

2.1 GISP-1050: Addition of “Agnew” Connection Point

A new connection point, named “Agnew” will be added to the GBB (WA) Network Topology map effective 1 May 2019 (Figure 1). This change is required as a new connection point (code CGGP-AGNEW) will be established on the Goldfields Gas Pipeline on this effective date.

2.2 GISP-960: IE11 Caching Issue

When reloading the Network Topology map after a change Internet Explorer 11 would cache the old visualisation files and not display the changes. Code improvements were required to ensure new visualisation files loaded each time the GBB (WA) was accessed from IE11.

2.3 GISP-993: Production and Consumption Flows Visualisations

In the Consumption and Production Flows charts, that allow visualisation of the output from each Registered Production Facility and consumption from each GBB Zone, the text that identified either the Production Facility and Zone would not render correctly, cutting out part of the text. A change to the visualisation code was required to render the chart in correct order to display the text.
