This week, AEMO, in collaboration with the Reform Delivery Committee (RDC), has released Version 5 of the <u>NEM Reform Implementation Roadmap</u> ('the Roadmap'). The Roadmap provides a holistic view of the NEM Reform Program's reform schedule and impact on the National Electricity and Gas Markets.

The volume and scope of the reforms to be implemented expands and evolves as we continue to move through the energy transition. Version 5 of the Roadmap reflects this growth along with updates to the current reform agenda, key changes in scope and/or timelines and the continued focus on Consumer Energy Resources (CER).

The changes were worked through in accordance with a formal governance arrangement established under the Program. The updated Roadmap and supporting materials are available in full on <u>AEMO's website</u>.

The key updates centre around CER and include:

- real-time data for consumers and the acceleration of smart meter deployment
- unlocking CER through flexible trading
- alignment of existing AEMO CER initiatives with those in the Commonwealth Government's <u>National Consumer Energy Resources Roadmap</u>.

Progress has also been made on several Market Interface Technology

Enhancements (MITE) initiatives following industry endorsement and AEMO approvals.
