The Participant Build Pack 1 – MIRN and Meter Status does not list all the combinations of Meter / MIRN statuses (including the removal of a regulator or installation of a Trailer Air Coupling) or provide a summary against the various JECs. AGL suggests that an issue be logged to update this sheet with an amended diagram and an updated table of JECs and Meter/MIRN statuses as this is very useful when reviewing a MIRN discovery response and determining the JECs needed to re-energise a site.
	Add text to PBP1 – Elements and FRC B2B System Interface Definitions that a single named person is to have their details populated in the Family name field. Note: this is a requirement of the Schema, which specifies the data to be provided per AS 4590, which in turn specifies that a single named person is to have that information populated in the Family Name field.
