Notice of determination on minor rules consultation procedure

The publication of this final report (**Final Paper**) concludes the process conducted by AEMO (**Process**) in respect of the proposal (**Proposal**) to consolidate relevant versions of the Retail Electricity Market Procedures (**Consolidating Procedures**) which have a shared effective date of 27 October 2025.

The Consolidating Procedures were:

- MSATS - Principles and Obligations for All Connection Points v6.2 and 7.

The Consolidation Proposal combined the Consolidating Procedures into MSATS - Principles and Obligations for All Connection Points v7.01 in the form published with the Amendment Paper.

The Consolidation Proposal did not involve any substantive amendments to the Consolidating Procedures. Rather, amendments to the Consolidating Procedures were minor and administrative given:

- The amendments did not affect the obligations or rights of market participants.
- The amendments did not require market participants to change internal processes or systems, including the way they send or retrieve information. As a result, market participants are not expected to incur any costs from the amendments.
- Any AEMO implementation expenditure will be minimal.

The previous changes to MSATS - Principles and Obligations for All Connection Points v6.2 and 7 were consulted on in 2024 and 2025, in accordance with the rules consultation procedures in NER 8.9. Accordingly, for the purposes of NER 8.9.4, the amendments to the Consolidation Procedures are minor and administrative.

In response to AEMO's notice of the consolidation proposal published on 25 September 2025, AEMO received comments from 1 stakeholder to the Issues Paper which is listed in Appendix A.

AEMO's final determination is to combine the Consolidating Procedures into MSATS - Principles and Obligations for All Connection Points v7.01 in the form published with this Final Report.
