### 3 2025 / 2026 Release Summary

### 4 **Environment Activities & Timings**

- AEMO provided an update on Pre-Prod refresh dates and outage timings for 2025 with the following updates made.
  - Pre-Prod Wholesale and Retail refresh supporting FPP (FO) Market Trial completed successfully.
    - Wholesale production copy for the refresh was taken on 17 Feb.
  - Retail production copy for the refresh was taken on 24 Feb.
  - Pre-prod Maintenance is being planned for the first 2 weeks of April. Don't anticipate an impact to the FPP Market Trial schedule however this will be confirmed via the ITWG and the FPP Market Trial Q&A Sessions.
  - Further pre-prod refresh has been scheduled for late Aug 2025 to support the ISF Market Trial.
- AEMO advised that changes made to Data Model 5.5.
  - IESS settlements transition ends with this DM Release.

# Frequency Performance Payments (FPP)

- The overall project status is Green. AEMO provided members with an update on activities since January 2025 and a general progress summary (refer to slide 14).
- AEMO intend to issue an invitation to a March session which will provide an overview of observed outcomes in the first 6-8 weeks of NFO.
  - The event will be held on Monday 24 March 2025, 11am-12pm Melbourne time. Register here
- AEMO is yet to receive a ruling from the ATO regarding the GST treatment of FPPs and will update participants as soon as information is available.
- AEMO will publish Draft updates to the Frequency Contribution Factors Procedure (FCFP) on 21 March.
- Further details on FPP-FO and Market Trail Planning is underway. Key information is outlined on slide 16 and 17 of the accompanying slide pack.
- Further update on Go live checkpoint was provided with information outlined on slide 18 through to 21.

# **SCADA Lite**

 AEMO advised that the overall project status is green. AEMO testing on track for completion 26 Apr 2025. Service guideline being developed and on track for 25 May 2025 with Go-live readiness checkpoint targeted for 28 May. In addition, SCADA lite Service will be available from 28 Jun 2025 for eligible participants to apply.

# **Enhancing Reserve Information (ERI)**

 AEMO provided an update on ERI activities and noted that the overall project status is green. AEMO added that integration testing complete is now completed, UAT remains on schedule with external milestones. AEMO provided a status update on ERI test strategy and scope with key details outlined on slide 28.

# **ST PASA Procedure and Recall Period**

- It was advised that a status of Amber due to late changes in NEM Reporting requirements which have delayed AEMO development and testing. No Participant or timeline impact. Final Report and ST PASA Procedure was published in February 2025.
- EMMS Data Model v5.5 available Preprod 25 Mar 2025
- Draft combined ERI/ ST PASA Industry Go-live Plan available early May 2025.

The overall status remains red until the re-plan of activities have been finalised and planned actions to recover the schedule are progressed. AEMO's approach to these activities have the minimisation of market implementation impact at the forefront.
