


Implementation Forum Governance, Scope and Engagement

Governance



- The Implementation Forum supports the implementation of AEMO reform initiatives outside of ESB initiatives, initially covering the November 2022 and May 2023 Releases.
- Focus Groups may be established and closed as required, in consultation with the Implementation forum.
- Focus Groups that have been established to date:
 - Industry Testing Focus
 Group
 - MDSR Focus Group

Implementation Forum Objectives

- The purpose of the Implementation Forum is to provide two-way communication between AEMO and market participants that are progressing projects/programs for the changes that will be implemented in November 2022 and May 2023.
- AEMO and IWG members will work together on the following objectives:
 - Identify and develop key milestones to ensure that readiness activities over the Releases are aligned with high level Program deliverables.
 - Provide oversight of Industry Testing.
 - Provide detailed expertise into the development of cutover and testing activities.
 - Identify and manage industry risks and issues.
 - Identify topics that require Focus Groups and provide direction to these groups and where applicable approval of the outcomes of these groups.

Implementation Forum Scope

- The Implementation Forum will be focused on Reform changes that will be implemented by AEMO during 2022 / 2023.
- Implementation Forum will be responsible for the development of key market readiness planning deliverables, including:
 - Industry Testing Strategy and Plan
 - Market Trial Strategy and Plan(s)
 - Data migration approaches and plans for MSDR
 - Industry Transition and Go Live Strategy and Cutover Plan(s)
