1 Welcome and previous meeting minutes

Martin Maticka (AEMO) opened the meeting at 1:02pm, welcomed attendees to WAGCF No. 22.

Martin noted a change to the agenda, item 4.0 DBP linepack incident update has been moved to the next WAGCF. The minutes from the previous WAGCF (26 May 2023) were endorsed. AEMO to publish the minutes as final on the website (action item 1.1).

2 WA Gas Statement of opportunities (GSOO) Formal Information Request (FIR) and Timeline

Christopher Meredith (AEMO) presented the preliminary analysis of the data received from the 2023 FIR process, noting data reconciliation is still underway, so findings are likely to change, and further analysis and final conclusions will be presented in the 2023 WA GSOO. Christopher also noted there will be a WA Gas Forecasting Reference Group held in September where there will be an opportunity to provide feedback on initial forecasts, followed by a WA Gas Consultative Forum in November providing an opportunity to provide further feedback on draft forecasts before publication in December.

3 Quarterly Energy Dynamics (QED) and Operational Update

Robert Jackson (AEMO) presented the key highlights from Quarter 2 QED that was published on 27 July 2023, noting:

- Q2 record high average gas-fired generation and Q2 record low average coal-fired generation.
- An increase in gas production and gas demand for electricity generation.
- Steps taken to overcome challenging operational conditions.
- Record high weighted average Balancing Price and Q2 record high STEM Price.

No other business was raised.

Martin Maticka (AEMO) informed participants that the date for the next WAGCF is scheduled for November 2023. The closed the meeting at 1:27pm.
