

Notice to Participants of an extension of time under NGR 135EG

This notice advises all Registered Participants and Bulletin Board Participants (Participants) that AEMO has decided, under Rule 135EG of the National Gas Rules (NGR), to extend the time limit of 40 days specified in Rule 135ED(3) to 60 days for the purposes of preparing an implementation and impact report (I&IR).

AEMO has made this decision after being advised by Jemena Gas Networks (NSW) that it will need additional time to complete its cost/benefits analysis on the options presented in the proposed procedure change STTM PPC 11-002 CG DSR Information Exchange—these options are for an information exchange related to sites providing demand side response during contingency gas events.

The extension of this time limit means that AEMO will prepare the I&IR within 20 days after submissions close on the PPC—due 30 September 2011—and subsequently publish the I&IR and associated notice within a further 10 days.
